The Apostle Paul viewed the church as the living body of Christ comprised of believers. Paul made no formal distinction between professional clergy and laity. The community had leaders but every believer had a ministry in building up the body. When the early believers gathered together, usually in someone's home, everyone brought something from God to share with the others.

Paul understood God's Spirit as gifting people for their specific ministries and leading them when they came together for worship. Guided by the Spirit, every believer was to use their spiritual gifts for the benefit of the church.

Paul wanted believers to be sensitive to the empowering of the Spirit in all they did. When believer's meet together, every individual is important and each one has an active role to play. Believer's must listen for God speaking His word - and be prepared to speak it - in all their relationships. Every believer is a crucial part of the body, called to be actively involved in it's growth.


